# Online Safety in the Curriculum

#### **Key Stage 1**

Pupils should be taught to:

• Use technology safely and respectfully, <u>keeping personal information private</u>, identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content or contact on the internet or other online technologies.

#### **Key Stage 2**

Pupils should be taught to:

Use technology, safely, respectfully and responsibly; <u>recognise</u>
 <u>acceptable/unacceptable behaviour</u>; identify a <u>range</u> of ways to report
 concerns about content and contact.



# stay safe online

Remember the 5 SMART rules when using the internet and mobile phones.

- SAGES Keep safe by being careful not to give out personal information such as your full name, email address, phone number, home address, photos or school name to people you are chatting with online.
  - many Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Only do so with your parents' or carers' permission and even then only when they can be present.
- CCCPTIPG's Accepting emails, IM messages, or opening files, pictures or texts from people you don't know or trust can lead to problems they may contain viruses or nasty messages!
  - RELIABLES Information you find on the internet may not be true, or someone online may be lying about who they are. Make sure you check information before you believe it.
- TELL 8 Tell your parent, carer or a trusted adult if someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried, or if you or someone you know is being bullied online.











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
